**Turn art into gift tags:** This can be done in one of two ways: 1) You can either cut up already made art work, or 2) cut out different shapes then let your artist decorate the pre-cut gift tags. Punch a hole, add some ribbon and attach it to the gift.

**Turn it into the real thing:** Of all the art work that your child creates, there are those they create in minutes and those they work on for days to get it perfect. For the “perfect ones” buy a nice frame or even get a custom frame made. Many craft stores offer half-off pricing on custom framing either in the Sunday paper or on their websites. These framed pictures also make great gifts.
